About **FIPS**

The FIPS is a scientific federation of all the physiologists of India. It is affiliated to the Federation of Asian and Oceanian Physiological Societies. The Association of Physiologists and Pharmacologists of India (APPI), Physiologists Society of India (PSI), Indian Society for Comparative Animal Physiology (ISCAP), and Society for Animal Physiologists of India (SAPI) are its constituent's societies. These societies represent physiologists from medical science stream, science stream, comparative animal science and veterinary science. In addition to its prime duty of facilitating the interaction of physiologists working under various disciplines in India, it also forms the nodal point for the interaction of various physiological societies of the country with the international bodies.

About **ESIC**

The promulgation of Employees' State Insurance Act, 1948 (ESI Act), by the Parliament was the first major legislation on social Security for workers in independent India. The legislation on creation and development of a full proof multi-dimensional Social Security system. India, notwithstanding, thus, took the lead in providing organized social protection to the working class through statutory provisions.

The ESI Act 1948, encompasses certain health related eventualities that the workers are generally exposed to; such as sickness, maternity, temporary or permanent disablement, Occupational disease or death due to employment injury, resulting in loss of wages or earning capacity-total or partial.

The scheme was inaugurated in Kanpur on 24th February 1952 (ESIC Day) by then Prime Minister Pandit Jawahar Lal Nehru. The scheme was simultaneously launched at Delhi as well and the initial coverage for both the centres was 1,20,000 employees. Our first prime Minister was the first honorary insured person of the Scheme and the declaration form bearing his signature is a prized possession of the Corporation.

During the 68 years of its existence, ESIC has grown from strength to strength and the Corporation owes it, most of all, to the commitment, dedication and perseverance of persons like Prof. Adarkar and Dr. Katial.

ESIC Medical College & Hospital, Faridabad (under ministry of Labour & Employment, Govt. of India) as a Healthcare, Academic and Research Institute. ESIC apart from health care, offer comprehensive social security to approximately 3.49 crores insured persons & around 15 crores beneficiaries with monthly income upto Rs. 21,000 provides health care to the insured persons (IPs), and their beneficiaries earning less than Rs. 21,000 per month. This institute started in 2015 and currently 500 students are enrolled in the MBBS curriculum.
